#### ***YOUTH TRAPSHOOTERS (Grades 6 through 12)***

**Manchester Sportsman Club** will host an informational meeting for parents and students in grades 6 through 12, who are interested in participating in the national Scholastic Clay Target Program (SCTP). SCTP is a nationwide shooting competition that gives young adults the opportunity to learn how to shoot trap and compete for state and national titles, plus college scholarships and prizes. The meeting will be held **at MSC Clubroom, 8501 Grossman Rd., February 27, 2010 at 10:00AM.**

The Scholastic Clay Target Program provides junior and senior high school-age young adults with the opportunity to showcase their competitive shooting skills and earn state and national recognition. The program is designed to instill in participants safe firearms handling, commitment, responsibility, leadership and teamwork.

The Scholastic Clay Target Program is a cooperative effort between the Scholastic Shooting Sports Foundation (SSSF), and the governing bodies for trapshooting, skeet shooting, and sporting clays shooting - the Amateur Trapshooting Association (ATA), the National Skeet Shooting Association (NSSA) and the National Sporting Clays Association (NSCA), respectively. The SCTP program has grown from 150 students in 2001 to the present day with over 16,000 participants. In addition to the growth, there is a movement of many middle and high schools to offer shotgun shooting sports as a recognized school sanctioned lettering sport. Tennessee leads the way with over 30 high schools offering trapshooting as a high school varsity lettering sport.
